A Message from the President of the PA Black Conference on Higher Education, Inc. (PBCOHE)

We, the members of the PA Black Conference on Higher Education, Inc., stand with Congressman Elijah Cummings of Maryland, Congresswomen Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez of New York, Rashida Tlaib of Michigan, Ilhan Omar of Minnesota and Ayanna Pressley of Massachusetts, against the most recent verbal assaults on them by the current president. This current occupant of the White House continues to spew vitriol and hate-laced speech which further divides this nation. He must be held accountable for these negative attacks on our nation, in general, and on our duly elected members of Congress who are of color.
